Eligibility:

- 1. Ph.D. Research Scholars of all Social Sciences from Universities / Institutions belonging to Karnataka only are eligible to apply for this Research Methodology Course.
- 2. The Ph.D. Research Scholars who have completed their Coursework examination / Part I and have registered for their Ph.D. from the Academic Year 2020-21 onwards are eligible to apply for this course work. The candidates must upload a PhD coursework certificate / Part-I Memo in the online application form.
- 3. The candidates who have under gone similar training courses earlier are not eligible to apply again.

However, the fellowship holders are not entitled to availing TA reimbursement.
- 5. Attendance for all the sessions throughout the Research Methodology Course period is compulsory or otherwise the certificate shall not be issued.
- 6. The Selected Candidates are required to bring their own personal laptop for the purpose of Hands-on-Experience.
